Moving from Kindergarten/Pre-School to Primary School can be an exciting but challenging time in your child's life. At Streeton Primary School, we know the importance of ensuring that your child experiences an enjoyable and happy transition and we will again offer an extensive transition program during Term 4, for students attending in 2021. The Streeton Transition to School program will consist of at least 6 sessions. More information on the days and dates will follow. You can register your child in the Transition program by contacting the school office on 9435 6070.

The activities in the transition program will focus on familiarising your child with the school environment in a friendly, stress-free way. These activities have been designed to:

- encourage socialisation
- develop confidence
- experience some of the opportunities that Streeton offers
- meet the Foundation teachers and students they will work with in 2021
- develop fine and gross motor skills
- explore a variety of equipment and resources

The classroom location for these transition sessions will be A7 (the Discovery Centre), which is at the end of the Junior School wing. Parents will be able to take their children to the school office on the first day of transition where they will be met by the Transition/Foundation teachers and directed to the appropriate classroom. Parents are not required to stay with their child in the classroom during these transition sessions.
